Data Management for Insurance Professionals

Is an introductory course that provides a high-level overview of insurance data management principles.

This class covers the information contained in the companion study guide, and students have an opportunity to take the DMIP exam once they are comfortable with the material. Students who pass the exam will receive a certificate of completion.

Insurance Data Quality

Offers participants an opportunity to learn about data quality principles and identify challenges that can hinder data quality.

The full-day program includes case studies for interactive participation.
